AWARDS, POINTS & SHOW APPROVALS

APPROVALS: The 2023 LAPPC championship show is conducted under the rules of the North American Peruvian Horse Association (NAPHA) as an APP (All Peruvian Paso) Championship Show. The show is drug free with testing (PER USEF RULES). Only horses with registration certificates issued by NAPHA, PPHRNA, AAOBPPH, or the PHAC may participate. It is operated in accordance with the current official Rules and Regulations of Horse Showing and Peruvian Paso Breed Standards of NAPHA. Every person who participates in this show is responsible for a knowledge of and is subject to these NAPHA rules. Rule books may be obtained www.napha.net. A copy of the rules will be available for review at the show through the show steward. Everything is being done to conduct the show on the highest possible plane and for the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudicating officials to be found are selected and they will place awards upon the horses as they see them presented in the ring, without regard to previous records. This show will confer a minimum of double points for the NAPHA Medallon de Plata, Medallon de Oro, Medalon de Bronce, Medallon de Diamante, Zone 2 and High Point Performance Horse Awards.

ENTRY CHECKLIST

Before you send in your entry package, please check to be sure you include the following:

- (1) A completed and signed Entry form (front and back).
- (2) A copy of each horse's registration paper.
- (3) Agent papers if you are not the owner of record.
- (4) A signed copy of the Declaration of Amateur Status, if showing in an amateur class must be on file with NAPHA, or filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Novices must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the NAPHA or the show secretary, prior to the start of the show.
- (5) A signed check, **made out to LAPPC** for the total amount shown on the Entry form or credit card authorization.

Pre-entries must be postmarked by May 15th, 2023 to avoid late entry fees.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE OF HORSES: Stalls will be available from 8:00 a.m., Thursday May 25 through 3 pm Sunday May 28th at the same rate. Arrivals prior to that, or staying Sunday night must contact the Barn Manager to make arrangements, and pay a \$50/stall/night extra fee. Our of state arrivals are permitted on Wednesday with advance notice and extra night fees.

STABLING FACILITIES: All stalls must be reserved by telephone with the Barn Manager, or there is no guarantee of stalls or positioning. Entry description is no guarantee, even though every effort will be made to inform the Barn Manager of desires written on the entry forms. Stalls will be assigned at the Barn Manager's discretion, with consideration for Large Sponsors, Large Ranches, advance notice and past entries. Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to stalls or premises. All end stalls must be decorated. Any end stalls that are decorated by someone that has not purchased an end stall will be charged for that end stall. ABSO-LUTELY NO NAILS OR SCREWS IN STALL WALLS!

The **GROUNDS FEE** for those showing out of a trailer is \$25/day/horse.

SHAVINGS: Bedding will consist of complimentary first bedding of equivalent of FOUR bags of shavings provided with each stall housing a horse. Additional shavings can be purchased at Tractor Supply next door.

PAYMENT POLICY:

- LAPPC cannot extend credit of any kind to anyone—NO EXCEPTIONS. All entries must be paid in full by cash, good check, money order, cashiers check at the time the entry is submitted.
- Any entry received without proper payment and/or copies of registration papers will be considered incomplete and may therefore be subject to Late Fees.
- If an exhibitor desires to add classes, horses, bedding, or any other expense during the show, these must be paid for immediately, or the Show secretary must be given a or a signed, currently dated good check.
- •Any exhibitor with history of bad checks or slow payments will be required to pay in cash or cashiers check.

Outstanding Debts

- Anyone owing a debt 60 days past due from the date of the first billing to NAPHA, or one of its approved shows may not be allowed to show in a NAPHA approved show in any capacity, including owner, trainer, rider, handler,
- No exhibitor who owes an outstanding debt to LAPPC for any reason will NOT be allowed to exhibit his/her horses until the balance is paid in full.

Returned Checks: There will be a \$50 penalty if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. Any history of bad checks with LAPPC will be required to pay in cash or credit card UP FRONT. NO EXCEPTIONS!

HOSPITALITY: Coffee, and snacks will be served in the barn or near the show office from 7:30 AM mornings of the show.

NOTES ON ENTRIES:

Substitution of Entries / Refunds: If a horse is entered and then is unable to perform, another horse may be substituted at no additional cost. Refunds will be considered only if a veterinarian certificate is submitted to the Show Secretary before the close of the show. The Show Managers have the final authority on refunds. No refunds will be approved until after the close of the show.

Office Fee: If a horse is entered, with or without fees, and then withdrawn from competition for any reason, the office fee will still apply.

Past Champion of Champions: When entering a returning Champion into the Champion of Champions class, please note how the horse is qualified to enter (e.g. 2010 National Champion of Champions or 2011 LAPPC Ch of Ch). The fee for horses <u>only</u> entering a Champion of Champions class in the entire show is \$100.

Entry Form: One per owner of horse/s. Multiple entries by same exhibitor does not qualify as "per owner of horse/s". Must be signed by the registered owner of the horses. Agents may only sign if agent form (or copy) is provided with entry.

Registration Papers: All entries must include a copy of the current registration papers for each horse. Papers must be issued from NAPHA or PHAC, in accordance with NAPHA show approval guidelines. All male horses, shown in any bit class must provide registration papers indicating Stallion or Gelding, as outlined in NAPHA rules. NO MALE (T) REGISTERED HORSE WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY IN a 4+ BIT CLASS AT THIS SHOW! Registration must be correct before entry!

Responsibility: It is the responsibility of the owner or agent of each horse to complete the entry form in full. Each change of class, rider or handler should be made on a supplemental entry form provided at the show office. No horses should enter any classes without submission of these forms and fees paid in advance (or open check on file).

GENERAL INFORMATION & SHOW RULES:

Judge: If, for any reason, the judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute the judge with another qualified judge. No one shall approach a judge at any time without first obtaining permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. NAPHA rules prohibit any act or remark during the show which is considered offensive and/or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging.

Judge's Authority: The judge has the authority to place a horse as he/she feels the horse merits and to excuse horses that are unsound, do not gait, or are ill-mannered or create a safety hazard. The judge shall rank entrants from first through reserve (entries permitting) without vacating any places.

Admission to the Ring: No person will be permitted to enter the ring except class participants, the judge, his/her assistants and Show Officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. Attendants entering the ring must be dressed in whites.

Three Minute Rule and Tack Changes: The three minute rule will be strictly enforced. Three minutes after the first horse in a class enters the ring, the gate will be closed and judging will begin. A 5 minute extension can be granted if the entrant notifies the show office or gate steward prior to the final class call. Exhibitors are cautioned to plan classes to avoid the need for requests for extensions.

Scratched Classes / Rider Changes: All scratches and rider changes MUST be made to the Show Office three classes prior. Class Substitutions for the same horse will be allowed. No refund for scratched classes with out vet excuse. Classes may be substituted for same horse.

Late, Post Entries: Entries received after May 15th 2023 close date must pay a \$20 per horse Late Entry fee. Any entries received that are not complete by the entry deadline will also pay the late fee. Post class entries will be allowed up to THREE classes prior to the class being entered at no additional charge. You will not be permitted to add classes at the gate!

Dogs: Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs will not be allowed in buildings or in arenas. It is the policy of the Showgrounds to allow animal control to come on the grounds throughout the year to pick up those dogs not on a leash. Any dog owner whose dog is caught loose on the Showgrounds, is subject to a \$25 fine for the first offense and \$50 for the second offense. A third offense will result in expulsion from the Showgrounds.

Damage to Stalls/Barn: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage or alterations incurred by them or their agents to barns or other Hansen Dam properties. NO NAILS OR SCREWS IN STALL WALLS ALLOWED!

Championship and "Best of" Class Entry: Horses which win first or second place in a qualifying regular class will be automatically entered by the show secretary, & charged the fee. Entry is not mandatory but an owner who elects to not enter must notify the show secretary, or else they will automatically be charged the class entry fee. +Junior Classes will be run together, but awarded separately

Alternative Attire allowed in the Amateur Performance, Open Performance Divisions

This is NOT mandatory, rather an option for those who would like to try something different!

Not permitted for Breeding or Pisos Divisions!

- Hat must be of Peruvian style as outlined by NAPHA rules.
- Blazer or suit-style vest MUST be worn. Bolero jackets ok. No ponchos.
- Boots/belts in colors are outlined in NAPHA rules. Boots may be worn outside of pants.
- Polinas & Half Chaps allowed
- Slacks/pants must be long enough to cover ankle and boot tops.
- Split skirts/sidesaddle aprons for women as provided for in NAPHA rules.
- Shirts must be collared, long-sleeve as per NAPHA rules.
- Scarves/ties include traditional Peruvian white scarf, bolo tie, western crisscross tie, necktie or brooch.

Colors allowed are: Black, shades of grey (charcoal to light), browns (dark to tan/beige, khaki), shades of **muted** greens (olive to hunter), blues (light to dark navy), burgundy (**no bright reds or pinks**), white, creams, ivory. Small pinstripes for jackets as outlined in NAPHA rules is acceptable. **NO BLUE DENIM**

- NO SEQUINS
- NO LOUD/BRIGHT PATTERNS

NOTES ON CLASSES:

NEW Requirement to enter Mares & Stallions Breeding Championship& Champion of Champions classes, you will be required to enter your respective Zootecnico Class

Junior Classes: Juniors are those individuals who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of January 1 of the year of the show. Junior Classes will be run as a single class; however, they will be judged separately and separate awards will be presented for each age group. Bareback pads are optional for riders in bareback classes. Helmets must be worn by all juniors 12 and under, and helmets are recommended for the older juniors.

Junior Equitation: No ponchos are allowed. Jackets are ok.

Junior Showmanship in Bit: Juniors have two minutes to execute a pattern of their own making. No tricks are permitted (see NAPHA rules for clarification). No ponchos or jackets.

Junior Bareback Equitation: Bareback pads are allowed. Ponchos are not allowed. Jackets are allowed

NAPHA rules pertaining to Amateur/Professional and Novice rules:

Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Amateurs" only must have a signed NAPHA Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA, or filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateurs must file annually. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur if after their 18th birthday they have not engaged in any of the activities identified in PART X Glossary of Terms, Section 10 Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under NAPHA rules must be listed on the NAPHA website as an Amateur or have signed a NAPHA Amateur Declaration and filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. See PART X GLOSSARY OF TERMS for complete definition of Amateur and Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules.

Novice Classes: Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Novices" only must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the NAPHA, or with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show. Novices must file this form annually. An exhibitor (18 years and older) can compete in the Novice Division for a period of 3 years. If the Novice, at the end of 3 years has not competed in more than 8 NAPHA approved shows during that period they may extend the time period for another 3 years (double shows count as one show). However, if at any time, a Novice competes and wins a Champion title in gait, breeding, or performance (any other Division above the level of Novice) they will be immediately excluded from competing in the Novice Division at future shows.

Owner: The name on the certificate of ownership, issued by the NAPHA, AAOBPPH, PPHRNA, OR PHAC, and their minor children. If the horse is owned by a ranch, corporation, or a family trust the individuals' names must be registered with the NAPHA. Lessees will not be allowed to show leased horses in classes where only the owner is allowed to ride.

High Point Awards: In the event of a tie for any high point award, ties will be broken by the number of 1st places won, then 2nds, then 3rds, etc.




Amateur to Ride Performance, open tack & attire: Judged as a performance class, any mix of tack and attire allowed - non peruvian saddles/attire permitted.

Presentation of Premio del Futuro de la Raza: This trophy is awarded by the Judge, at his discretion, to the young mare or stallion that he feels shows the greatest potential for the future of the breed. The winner will be selected from entries in classes 1,2,5,6,28,30. Horses must be entered in at least one of the above listed classes to qualify. (Not a championship, Judges award only)
