The Los Amigos Peruvian Paso Club and The Copper State Peruvian Paso Club are excited to present the 2024 championship horse show. We welcome you to join us for a great fun show! Awards, Points & Show Approvals

APPROVALS: The 2024 Cactus Classic championship show is conducted under the rules of the North American Peruvian Horse Association (NAPHA) as an APP (All Peruvian Paso) Championship Show. The show is drug free with testing (PER USEF RULES) increasing points for year end awards. Only horses with registration certificates issued by NAPHA, PPHRNA, AAOBPPH, or the PHAC may participate. It is operated in accordance with the current official Rules and Regulations of Horse Showing and Peruvian Paso Breed Standards of NAPHA. Every person who participates in this show is responsible for a knowledge of and is subject to these NAPHA rules. Rule books may be obtained at www.napha.net. A copy of the rules will be available for review at the show through the show steward and at the show office. Everything is being done to conduct the show on the highest possible plane and for the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudicating officials to be found are selected and they will place awards upon the horses as they see them presented in the ring, without regard to previous records. This show will confer a minimum of double points for the NAPHA Medallon de Plata, Medallon de Oro, Medallon de Bronce, Medallon de Diamante, Zone 2 and High Point Performance Horse Awards.

The 2024 Cactus Classic is also approved by the PHAC for points.

Fee Information for Junior Exhibitors

A Generous Donation from Daniel Christman and Thea Pichel pays all entry fees for Junior Rider division classes for 6-12 and 13-18. Any junior rider using the same horse for all 5 of their junior division classes will also have their horses stall paid for through this donation.

Juniors will have their High Point of Show awards on Sunday after class 56 and before lunch. All juniors showing during the weekend are welcomed at this time to partake in a Juniors only Barrida. Once concluded, junior exhibitors are invited to lunch with the judges and show officials - an opportunity for our juniors to hear from the judges.

ENTRY CHECKLIST

Sending in your entry package, please check to be sure you include the following:

- (1) A completed and signed Entry form (front and back).
- (2) A copy of each horse's registration paper.
- (3) Agent papers, filed with NAPHA, if you are not the owner of record.
- (4) A signed copy of the Declaration of Amateur Status, if showing in an amateur class must be on file with NAPHA, or filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Novices must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the NAPHA or show secretary, prior to the start of the show.
- **(5)** A signed check, **made out to Cactus Classic** for the total amount of entry or indicate on your entry form if you would like an invoice sent via email/text via Square. Pre-entries must be postmarked by April 29th, 2024 to avoid late entry fees.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE OF HORSES: Stalls will be available from 8:00 a.m., Wed May 8th through Monday May 13th. Arrivals prior to that, or staying Monday night must contact the Barn Manager to make arrangements, and pay a \$35/stall fee.

STABLING FACILITIES: Stalls will be reserved based on the following criteria;

- Cactus Classic Championship Show Sponsors will be given priority barn
 placement, all end stalls on the South side of A Barns, closest to main arena will
 be held for those purchasing Emerald Idol, Saguaro, Golden Barrel and Prickly
 Pear sponsorship packages. If you would like to be a Cactus Sponsor, contact
 Thea directly to arrange your barn placement now.
- After April 29th, barn placements will then be released first to those who have purchased show advertising and/or class sponsorships and then in the order in which paid entries are received.
- We will work to accommodate every request to the best we are able while making sure show sponsors are given priority.

Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to stalls or premises. All end stalls must be decorated. Any end stalls that are decorated by someone that has not purchased an end stall will be charged for that end stall. ABSOLUTELY NO NAILS OR SCREWS IN STALL WALLS!

The **GROUNDS FEE** for those showing out of a trailer is \$30/day/horse.

SHAVINGS: First bedding is 4 bags with each horse/tack stall. No outside shavings. Additional shavings may be purchased on entry form or during the show.

PAYMENT POLICY:

- The Cactus Classic cannot extend credit of any kind to anyone—NO EXCEPTIONS. All entries must be paid in full by cash, good check, money order, cashiers check at the time the entry is submitted or have indicated on entry to have invoice emailed or texted. Invoice should be paid within 2 days of receipt.
- Any entry received without proper payment or paid invoice within 2 days and/or copies of registration papers will be considered incomplete and may therefore be subject to Late Fees.
- If an exhibitor desires to add classes, horses, bedding, or any other expense during the show, these must be paid for immediately, or the Show secretary must be given a signed, currently dated good check. If paying by card, the same invoicing guidelines as laid out above apply.
- •Any exhibitor with history of bad checks or slow payments will be required to pay in cash or cashiers check.

Outstanding Debts

- Anyone owing a debt 60 days past due from the date of the first billing to NAPHA, or one of its approved shows may not be allowed to show in a NAPHA approved show in any capacity, including owner, trainer, rider, handler,
- No exhibitor who owes an outstanding debt to LAPPC or CSPPC for any reason will NOT be allowed to exhibit his/her horses until the balance is paid in full. **Returned Checks:** There will be a \$100 penalty if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. This same fee will apply for Square invoiced payments that are cancelled causing a fee to the shows account. Any history of bad checks with LAPPC or CSPPC will be required to pay in cash or credit card UP FRONT. NO EXCEPTIONS!

HOSPITALITY: Coffee, and snacks will be served in the barn or near the show office from 7:30 AM mornings of the show.

Notes on entries:

Substitution of Entries / Refunds: If a horse is entered and then is unable to perform, another horse may be substituted at no additional cost. Refunds will be considered only if a veterinarian certificate is submitted to the Show Secretary before the close of the show. The Show Managers have the final authority on refunds. No refunds will be approved until after the close of the show.

Office Fee: If a horse is entered, with or without fees, and then withdrawn from competition for any reason, the office fee will still apply.

Past Champion of Champions: When entering a returning Champion into the Champion of Champions class, please note how the horse is qualified to enter (e.g. 2010 National Champion of Champions or 2011 LAPPC Ch of Ch). The fee for horses only entering a Champion of Champions class in the entire show is \$110.

Past NAPHA US National Ch of Ch & PHAC National Ch of Ch may enter directly to their respective champion of champions class at this show.

Entry Form: One per owner of horse/s. The NAPHA issues a registration number per owner entity. This number is considered one owner. Multiple entries by same exhibitor does not qualify as "per owner of horse/s". Must be signed by the registered owner of the horses. Agents may only sign if agent form (or copy) is provided with entry.

Registration Papers: All entries must include a copy of the current registration papers for each horse. Papers must be issued from NAPHA or PHAC, in accordance with NAPHA show approval guidelines. All male horses, shown in any bit class must provide registration papers indicating Stallion or Gelding, as outlined in NAPHA rules. NO MALE (T) REGISTERED HORSE WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY IN a 4+ BIT CLASS AT THIS SHOW! Registration must be correct before entry!

Responsibility: It is the responsibility of the owner or agent of each horse to complete the entry form in full. Each change of class, rider or handler should be made on a supplemental entry form provided at the show office. No horses should enter any classes without submission of these forms and fees paid in advance (or open check on file).

General information & show rules:

Judge: If, for any reason, the judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute the judge with another qualified judge. No one shall approach a judge at any time without first obtaining permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place. NAPHA rules prohibit any act or remark during the show which is considered offensive and/or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging.

Judge's Authority: The judge has the authority to place a horse as he/she feels the horse merits and to excuse horses that are unsound, do not gait, or are ill-mannered or create a safety hazard. The judge shall rank entrants from first through reserve (entries permitting) without vacating any places.

Admission to the Ring: No person will be permitted to enter the ring except class participants, the judge, his/her assistants and Show Officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. Attendants entering the ring must be dressed in whites.

Three Minute Rule and Tack Changes: The three minute rule will be strictly enforced. Three minutes after the first horse in a class enters the ring, the gate will be closed and judging will begin. A 5 minute extension can be granted if the entrant notifies the show office or gate steward prior to the final class call. Exhibitors are cautioned to plan classes to avoid the need for requests for extensions.

Scratched Classes / Rider Changes: All scratches and rider changes MUST be made to the Show Office three classes prior. Class Substitutions for the same horse will be allowed. No refund for scratched classes without vet excuse. Classes may be substituted for same horse. You will not be permitted to add classes at the gate!

Late, Post Entries: Entries received after April 29th 2024 close date must pay a \$25 per horse Late Entry fee. Any entries received that are not complete by the entry deadline will also pay the late fee. Post class entries will be allowed up to THREE classes prior to the class being entered at no additional charge.

Dogs: Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Dogs will not be allowed in buildings or in arenas. It is the policy of the Showgrounds to allow animal control to come on the grounds throughout the year to pick up those dogs not on a leash. Any dog owner whose dog is caught loose on the Showgrounds, is subject to a \$100 fine for the first offense and \$150 for the second offense. A third offense will result in expulsion from the Showgrounds.

Health Certifications: All horses arriving must have health certificates issued within 30 days of the show.

Championship and "Best of" Class Entry: Horses which win first or second place in a qualifying regular class will be automatically entered by the show secretary, & charged the fee. Entry is not mandatory but an owner who elects to not enter must notify the show secretary, or else they will automatically be charged the class entry fee. Previous LAPPC and CSPPC Champions and LAPPC, CSPPC and US National NAPHA & PHAC National Champion of Champions may enter directly into their Champion of Champion Division. Returning Champions must be pre-entered by start of classes on May 10th or will be charged an additional late entry fee of \$50. You may qualify for Champion of Champions at the 2024 Cactus show or enter as a returning Champion, you cannot do both.

Alternative Attire allowed in all Performance Divisions

This is NOT mandatory, only an option for those who would like to try something different! We welcome this in Open, Amateur, Novice and Junior Performance Classes.

Not permitted for Breeding or Pisos Divisions!

- Hat must be of Peruvian style as outlined by NAPHA rules.
- Blazer or suit-style vest MUST be worn. Bolero jackets ok. No ponchos.
- Boots/belts in colors outlined in NAPHA rules. Boots may be worn outside of pants.

If under/inside of pants, pants must be long enough to cover ankle and boot tops

- Polinas & Half Chaps allowed
- Split skirts/sidesaddle aprons for women as provided for in NAPHA rules.
- Shirts must be collared, long-sleeve as per NAPHA rules.
- Scarves/ties include traditional Peruvian white scarf, bolo tie, western crisscross tie, necktie or brooch.

Colors allowed are: Black, shades of grey (charcoal to light), browns (dark to tan/beige, khaki), shades of **muted** greens (olive to hunter), blues (light to dark navy), burgundy **(no bright reds or pinks)**, white, creams, ivory. Small pinstripes for jackets as outlined in NAPHA rules is acceptable. **NO BLUE DENIM**

- NO SEQUINS NO LOUD/BRIGHT PATTERNS

Notes On Classes:

Requirement to enter Mares, Stallions and Geldings Breeding/Luxury Championships & Ch. of Champions classes, will be required to enter respective Zootecnico Class

Junior Classes: Juniors are those individuals who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of January 1 of the year of the show. Junior Classes will be run as a single class; however, they will be judged separately and separate awards will be presented for each age group. Bareback pads are optional for riders in bareback classes. Helmets must be worn by all juniors 12 and under, and helmets are recommended for the older juniors.

Junior Equitation: No ponchos allowed. Jackets are ok. Cones will not be called. **Junior Showmanship in Bit:** Juniors have two minutes to execute a pattern of their own making. No tricks are permitted (see NAPHA rules for clarification). No ponchos or jackets.

Junior Bareback Equitation: Bareback pads are allowed. Ponchos are not allowed. Jackets are allowed. Cones will not be called.

Notes On Classes (cont.):

Number of Horses in a Class: Per NAPHA rules, classes with more than 4 horses have specific instructions on the number of laps that a horse must complete prior to being excused for cause. Please read and be familiar with NAPHA Rules, page 13, Letter c, Judges Consideration, Section 1.

Performance Classes: Backing is the only required maneuver as defined in NAPHA rule book. Performance classes will be run with maneuvers at the judges' and show's discretion for time consideration. Be prepared for performance classes to be run individually from class to class based on number of entrants in class. Expect advanced serpentines and maneuvers in Championship level classes.

Amateur Level 1 & 2 Classes: If both divisions have 4 or fewer entries, the classes will be run together and judged separately. If both divisions have 4 or more entries, the classes will be run separate.

AOTR: Is Amateur Owner to Ride. Amateur declaration must be on file with NAPHA and rider must be registered owner of horse. Lessees are not considered owner.

Equitation Classes: Equitation classes will not include serpentine maneuvers in any division. Equitation will focus on the riders seat, hands, position and movement with the horse.

Peruvian Tack & Attire: Horse and rider should be in full Peruvian tack and attire including pellon and spurs. Horses shown in bit. Ponchos are required. This is judged as a breeding class and qualifies for the Breeding Mares, Stallions and Luxury Championships. This class is for exhibitors 18 years of age and older as retrancas are required.

Breeder Appreciation: This is an exhibition offered this inaugural year to pay tribute to Rocking M Ranch. All horses bred from Rocking M Ranch are encouraged to enter this exhibition. It will not be judged. Full tack is required.

Pairs Performance: Entries will be two horse and two rider combinations. The class will be run as a performance class and maneuvers will be called. Riders are encouraged to make this class fun and the show welcomes costumes, matching outfits anything to make this your class.

Champagne Calcutta: Please be sure to sign up for this class. The Calcutta will begin with a "bidding" portion where horse and rider combinations will be presented. Spectators will be able to bid on their favorite combination. Bidding will run like an auction where, highest bid 'going once, going twice, sold!" wins. The highest bid on each horse and rider combination is put into the pot. Each rider has the opportunity to buy half the winning bid on themselves to share half the total of what their ride wins. The champagne glasses will be filled and the class will commence. Riders must maintain a Paso Llano gait or will be excused from the class. When the class is concluded, the judges will measure glasses and put glasses in order from most champagne left in the glass to least. The pot will be split 1st though 5th place as follows:

1st Place-50%, 2nd Place-20%, 3rd Place-15%, 4th Place-10%, 5th Place-5%

- Friday May 10: The show office will be open at 7:30am, Hospitality will be available at 7:30 am. Meet with judges at 8:00 am at main arena for brief meet and greet. Classes begin 8:30 am. Lunch will be be 1 hour from end of class 13 to start of class 14.
- -Saturday May 11: The show office will open at 7:30am, Hospitality will be available at 7:30am. Classes begin 8:30 am. Lunch will be 1 hour from end of class 35 to start of class 36. Following class 48, Laureado awards will be presented and High Point Amateur, Crystal, Novice, Gelding, Mare, Stallion and Owner. Thursday night Taco Bar will be available for those who purchased dinner tickets and will end with classes 49 and 50. Sunday May 12: Show office and Hospitality start at 7:30am. Classes begin at 8:30 am. Junior High Point awards will be given after class 56b, with a Junior Barrida. Lunch will be 1 hour following Junior Barrida to start of class 57. High Point Trainer of Show will be awarded following class 69 followed by Barrida of Champions.

We welcome all Champion of Champions, Champions, Reserve Champions, High Point Award Winners and Juniors over 15 with parents signature on entry form to join the Barrida of Champions

NAPHA rules pertaining to Amateur/Professional and Novice rules:

Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Amateurs" only must have a signed NAPHA Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA, or filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateurs must file annually. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur if after their 18th birthday they have not engaged in any of the activities identified in PART X Glossary of Terms, Section 10 Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under NAPHA rules must be listed on the NAPHA website as an Amateur or have signed a NAPHA Amateur Declaration and filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. See PART X GLOSSARY OF TERMS for complete definition of Amateur and Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules.

Novice Classes: Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Novices" only must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the NAPHA, or with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show. Novices must file this form annually. An exhibitor (18 years and older) can compete in the Novice Division for a period of 3 years. If the Novice, at the end of 3 years has not competed in more than 8 NAPHA approved shows during that period they may extend the time period for another 3 years (double shows count as one show). **However, if at any time, a Novice competes and wins a Champion title in gait, breeding, or performance (any other Division above the level of Novice) they will be immediately excluded from competing in the Novice Division at future shows.**

Owner: The name on the certificate of ownership, issued by the NAPHA, AAOBPPH, PPHRNA, OR PHAC, and their minor children. If the horse is owned by a ranch, corporation, or a family trust the individuals' names must be registered with the NAPHA. Lessees will not be allowed to show leased horses in classes where only the owner is allowed to ride.

High Point Awards: In the event of a tie for any high point award, ties will be broken by the number of 1st places won, then 2nds, then 3rds, etc. All qualifying classes are listed on class list.





| All amatour exhibitors are required to declare their level (1 or 2) riding status prior to t |

All amateur exhibitors are required to declare their level (1 or 2) riding status prior to the beginning of this current Cactus Classic show. Also, a signed NAPHA amateur declaration form must be on file with NAPHA or completed prior to the start of show. (This form will not suffice for that requirement.) The criteria for level declaration are as follows:

Amateur Level 1: Exhibitor/rider has NOT won more than 25 Champion of Champions titles from any NAPHA or PHAC approved show, in AMATEUR performance, Open Performance, Breeding/Luxury and AOTR Performance, AOTR Breeding/Luxury Classes. (Best Gaited & Best Bozal not included).

Amateur Level 2: Exhibitor/rider HAS won more than 25 Champion of Champions titles from any NAPHA or PHAC approved show, in AMATEUR performance, Open Performance, Breeding/Luxury and AOTR Performance, AOTR Breeding/Luxury Classes. (Best Gaited & Best Bozal not included).

All exhibitors who are current NAPHA carded judges, must declare Level 2. Riders who have regained their amateur status from Professional status in the last 10 years must compete in Level 2.

General Rules:

If a horse qualifies for a Champion/Reserve & Champion of Champions class with a level 1 rider, only a level 1 rider can complete competition in that division. A returning Champion of Champions must choose the level they will compete in and cannot change levels. (Different level 1 riders can compete on the same horse for that division.) If a horse qualifies in the amateur division with riders of both level 1 and level 2, they can only compete in championships of one level, and must stay with that level rider in champion and champion of champions. IE: wins champion level 2, can only compete in champion of champions level 2

Exhibitors MUST qualify for the level they compete in. IE: a rider with less than 25 Champion of Champion Titles cannot choose to compete in level 2 as they do not qualify for level 2. Levels cannot be changed during a show.

If an exhibitor starts the year as a level 1 rider, but surpasses the 25 Champion of Champions titles requirement during the show year at any NAPHA approved or Canadian show, they are allowed to compete at a level 1 for the remainder of the current show year (applies to Cactus Classic show only).

If any exhibitor questions & chooses to protest a rider at either level, it will be up to that exhibitor to present their evidence to the Show Committee. If the committee affirms the violation of a level status, that exhibitor may face disqualification of wins for that particular show & must return all amateur level awards to the club.
